ANIMÉ LOS ANGELES 15 WILL RETURN JANUARY 10-13, 2019, AT THE ONTARIO CONVENTION CENTER AND DOUBLETREE ONTARIO AIRPORT HOTEL

Ontario, California October 23, 2018 - Animé Los Angeles (ALA) turns 15 in 2019 and once again the 4-day anime extravaganza will be held at Ontario Convention Center and Doubletree Ontario Airport hotel in Ontario California, January 10-13, 2019. In 2018 the Inland Empire welcomed over 11,300 unique anime and manga fans cementing itself as the one of the most loved anime convention in California.

Author Roland Kelts (*JapanAmerica: How Japanese Pop Culture Has Invaded The U.S.*) has been named Educational Guest of Honor, Producer Victor Frost as Panelist Guest of Honor, Todd Haberkorn (*Destiny 2: The Forsaken, Ben 10*) and Ezra Weisz (*Vampire Knight, Naruto*) will act as Master of Ceremonies Guests of Honor.

Guest announcements will continue from now until the show via press releases and social media.
