



DOWNTOWN STOREFRONT FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The City of Ontario, in its continuing effort to support the revitalization of the Historic Downtown Area, has created a Downtown Storefront Façade Improvement Program (Program) for all property owners within the designated program area. The purpose of the program is to provide financial assistance to commercial property and/or business owners to make qualifying façade improvement on Euclid Avenue facing buildings.

The goals of the Program are to facilitate commercial revitalization; stimulate private investment and customer patronage; preserve and beautify the Historic Downtown Area; and generate shopping opportunities by creating a pleasant walking environment resulting from the improved visual aesthetics of commercial building façades.



IS MY BUSINESS ELIGIBLE?

This program is for all Euclid Avenue facing businesses between Emporia Street and G Street.

WHAT TYPES OF IMPROVEMENTS CAN I MAKE?

Improvements may include, but are not limited to: new signage; new awnings; exterior lighting; and antigraffiti treatment to existing windows.
